Total Hours: 40 Hours, 4H/day, from 9:00 to 13:00, during 2 weeks (16 to 27 of July)

ECTS: 4

**Course Name:** Leadership in Hospitality and Tourism

Course Description: The course will have a theoretical and a practical component. Initially the main theoretical concepts and theories about leadership will be analyzed. Next, the effects of leadership and team management in hotel units will be analyzed. During the course, several practical works will be conducted in order to develop the main skills for leader a hotel unit.

#### Main Goals:

Adopt practices for the development of teams in hotel units

Train behavioral / emotional leadership skills in hotel management
